Code of conduct for Cheerleaders

Cheerleaders should strive to promote good sportsmanship by:

- ✓ Set positive examples for others
- ✓ Make every effort to develop their sporting ability in terms of skill technique and stamina
- ✓ Respect all members of their team
- ✓ Ensure prompt arrival and consistent attendance
- ✓ Treat opposing teams with respect at all time
- ✓ Strive to be modest in victory and gracious in defeat
- ✓ Not to use or tolerate inappropriate language

Code of conduct for coaches and volunteers

Coaches are role models and will set positive examples by:

- ✓ Respecting each person and treat equally within the context of the sport
- Placing the well being and safety of each participant above all other consideration
- ✓ Adhere to the guidelines as defined in the U.K.C.A. handbook
- Motivate Cheerleaders in the development of self-confidence, self esteem and team work
- ✓ Promote the positive aspects of the sport
- ✓ Consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance
- ✓ Not to use or tolerate inappropriate language
