Access to Club and Registration:

Drop off and collection times: Please arrive at the drop off and collection times; we will do our best to get all children signed in swiftly and safely.	DROP OFF AND COLLECTION TIMES: - Football all ages Drop off 9.00am Collection 3.30pm Extra time: Booked to drop from 8am and collect by 5.30pm

Registration:

- Registration will take place outside at the locations listed above.
- Registration is open from the session times you have booked please ensure children are not signed in before your booked time and that you arrive as close to your start time as possible; as our staff will be waiting to meet you at our outdoor registration point.
- Due to limited space we request that only 1 adult signs in a child.
- Please ensure children have appropriate footwear and clothing for the day; **please arrive wearing trainers (football boots can be brought to change into but all children must have trainers).**
- As a camp we will be doing the activity sessions outside where possible so please bring waterproof jacket and warm clothing. **Shin pads must be worn for football.**
- If your child has any medical conditions that were not declared upon booking or there has been a change in contact numbers that we need to be aware of, please ensure that you hand written information upon 'signing in' in the morning.
- A member of our staff will take note of your name, and the name of who is collecting your child that day. You will also be asked to give a 4 digit number on your first day at club – this will be used as a 'collection pin' that the person who collects will be asked at the end of the day.

Departure:

- Will take place at the same outdoor point as registration.
- We will not allow a child to leave the club unless they have signed out with a parent / guardian that was listed during the registration process in the morning. If there is a change of who is collecting your child please contact the club via the number above and ensure the person collecting knows the 4-digit pin you set.

What to bring:

- Food – Morning break snack, lunch and an afternoon snack **(no nuts – we are a nut free zone)**. Either a lunch box or plastic bag is ok. Please bring a refillable drinks bottle with **your child's name on** – children can refill water bottles during the day.
- Suitable clothing for the weather forecast.
- Waterproof jacket and warm clothing.
- Sun cream and sun hat – **please arrive wearing sun cream** – our staff cannot physically apply cream for the children but we will remind them to reapply during break times. The once a day sun cream works well if suitable.
- **Water Games** **ONLY APPLIES TO SUMMER CAMPS**
On hot days we often play water dodgeball, slip n slide and water tag guns; please feel free to pack a towel and spare clothes **on any days where the weather forecast is warm.**
- **Please do not bring any toys, phones, devices or any unnecessary items from home.**

Breaks and Lunch times:

Children will have a morning snack from their lunch box; and lunch at lunchtime. We will also be having a short afternoon break so children can bring a snack for this time as well if you wish.

Tuck shop:

We have a daily tuck shop open after lunch has been eaten. £1 for 4 sweets

End of day presentation:

Winners of any competitions or events will be announced; as well as the daily 'star award'. Final day of camp each child will receive their certificate.

Rehydration Station:

We have plenty of drink breaks throughout the day so please ensure that **each day children have a named drink bottle they can refill.**

Safety Information:

Staff are first aid trained, and will deal with any injuries sustained (**wearing PPE**) and an accident report form will be completed and communicated to the parent or guardian upon collection; or by text (for injuries where it is necessary).

Lost Property:

Our team do our very best to make sure all children have all their belongings before going home each day – any lost property will be bagged and stored at the end of the day, so please let us know if you've lost anything.

Suitable Clothing:

Please ensure children have

- Suitable clothing you don't mind them playing in
- Warm clothing on cold days including **rain jackets for outdoor play as we like the children to have the choice to go outside whatever the weather!**
- Trainers (football boots to change into for football group are allowed)
- Shin pads

Washing hands:

Children and staff will wash their hands frequently throughout the day.

If your child has Covid-19 we ask you follow the latest government guidance.
