



## Holiday Camps Terms and Conditions: Go-Karts Parent Consent

### **CONSENT agreed to upon booking (Please read carefully):**

- a) I agree to my son/ daughter to take part in Go-Karting (Pedal operate) with The Future Games.
- b) I confirm to the best of my knowledge that my son/ daughter does not suffer from any illness/ Injury or medical condition that could be affected during and after the Go-Karting session. And if so it has been declared upon booking.
- c) I confirm my son/daughter will be wearing the relevant clothing required to take part in the event. Trainers must be worn (not football boots).
- d) I understand and explained to my son/daughter that Go-Karting is a non-contact activity, however injuries could occur and accept that these risks are acceptable for my son/daughter to take part in the event.
- e) I understand that there is certain safety equipment that can be worn to minimiserisk of injury. TFG will provide children with helmets, knee pads and elbow pads while they are driving the Go-kart.
- f) I understand that injuries may occur from Go-Karting, I will not hold The Future Games or any other third party liable during such events under ANY circumstances.
- g) I understand that The Future Games and none of its affiliates accept any responsibility for loss, damage or injury caused during/following attendance of the Go-Karting.
- h) I give my consent that if an emergency medical situation arises,The Future Games may act as loco parentis. If the need arises for administration of first aid and/or other medical treatment which in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner may be necessary. I also understand that in such circumstances that all reasonable steps are made.
- i) I accept and consent by booking online that I waive the right to pursue any legal action against The Future Games during or following the scheduled event.
- j) I have read and fully understood this consent form and by signing this document agree for my son/daughter to take part in Go-Karting upholding the rules outlined in the safety briefing which will be given on the day of the event
